EMS Scholarship Application Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in the Seth Winkelmann Memorial EMS Scholarship, awarded by the Rock Community Firefighters Community Outreach Group 501c3. Scholarship(s) will be awarded to applicants residing in Jefferson County, Missouri. The following information will give you the guidelines on the qualifications, requirements and application process.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Seth Winkelmann Memorial EMS Scholarship is to assist people wishing to pursue a career in the fire and emergency services field, by reaching a higher level of performance through participation in professional development and educational programs.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Preference will be given to students enrolled at Windsor C-1 School District and Fox C-6 School District.
- Applicants that qualify for and need financial assistance will receive preference.
- Must have a valid Missouri ID.
- Must meet all physical fitness and/or medical requirements to enter the EMS program as outlined by the institution.
- Must not have any felony or 1st-degree misdemeanor convictions.
- Must have a driving record that would not preclude employment under Missouri Statute as an EMS provider.
- Must meet all eligibility requirements to attend the college or vocational school in which the scholarship is awarded for.
- Must agree to, and pass a background check.
- Must demonstrate a strong desire to pursue a career in the emergency services field.
- Must be a Jefferson County, Missouri resident.
- Completed application.

Qualified applicants need to submit:

- Background/Contact information.
- Proof of current enrollment or acceptance into an accredited EMS program.
- Two (2) professional letters of recommendation
- 250 minimum word essay stating why you want to pursue a career in emergency services and why you should be awarded the "Seth Winkelmann Memorial EMS Scholarship".

Process

All applications will be reviewed by our scholarship committee who will have the final selection authority. The scholarship(s) will be paid to those applicants chosen by the committee upon proof of acceptance to an accredited EMS program.
